HERO SPOTLIGHT

KARLA (KJ) - KOZERSKI - US NAVY

In 2023, KJ attended a four-day event. As a prior MSSN in the US Navy, and a teacher in North Carolina, KJ was an ideal person to have attended an event. "I got involved with OWS through Rachel Fox", says KJ. "We worked at the same school, and Rachel was talking about OWS. I asked if I could volunteer. Once she found out I was a veteran, she signed me up to attend as a Hero".

"During my time in the Navy, I was on the Color Guard and participated in a Women At Sea program" says KJ. "At the time, females weren't permitted on Guided Missile Cruisers. I was among 14 other females that spent a week at sea on these vessels. Females now serve on Guided Missile Cruisers!" KJ later became a teacher for Children with special needs. KJ lived in Concord, NC with her two children and two grandchildren. In her spare time, KJ likes to swim, garden, go walking, watch football, and do anything involving her arandsons!

"I had no idea what I was getting into when Rachel signed me up" says KJ. "The 2 days spent on the water were hard. I was 50 years old with arthritis and didn't know if I could do it. I didn't realize how fearful I was until I was behind that boat. Afraid of everything. That was the beauty of it all. Failure was not an option, and everyone involved was so supportive of each other. OWS gave me my confidence back!!! I never felt freer as I did when I finally got up and surfed. I left that lake feeling like the world was mine to conquer! Robbie and his team are simply amazing!"
